



### **351 Commercial Street**

- 1851 – Willis Banks had a storehouse here.**
- 1852 – Jacob Feldberg was the owner of the building.**
- 1855 – The Big Fire destroyed much of Old Town. Jacob Feldberg and Leopold Newman hired James Thompson to build this brick building for their clothing store.**
- 1855 – Jacob Feldberg took over the Clothing Emporium.**
- 1862 – Charles Higgins and James McBurney moved their Magnolia Saloon from the building next door into Feldberg's building.**
- 1874 – The building was in the hands of S. W. Willis, the postmaster. He remodeled the building for the post office.**
- 1878 – Willis sold the building to E. C. Snowden, the druggist, who had the building and drug store next door.**
- 1907 – The Placer County Creamery moved into the building.**
