- 1893 – Fire destroyed the wooden buildings here.**
- 1893 – Kee Chin bought the property from Ma Wing Quong and erected this brick building for his business and family home.**
- 1898 – Kee Chin ran a Chinese employment office here as well as selling groceries and provisions. He often exchanged goods for gold dust.**
- 1899 – Kee Chin advertised selling cattle, sheep, liquor, cigars, teas, exchanging gold dust and operating a Chinese employment office.**
- 1904 – Kee Chin advertised selling fish, oysters, vegetables and tea. Kee also offered Chinese workers for hire for mining and wood chopping.**
- 1942 – When Kee's wife, Yee Shee died in 1942, she had lived here for half a century.**
- 1959 – When Kee's son, Ma Wing Chong, called Buckskin died, he had lived here his whole life.**
