



The surface of the Great Basin is covered with Detritus from the Mountains composed of Gravel, Quartz, Serpentine and Volcanic Rock.

The waters of the Great Basin have no outlet but run into small Lakes and Marsh Patches.

Diameter 11° of Lat 10° of Longitude elevation above the Sea between 4 and 5000 feet.
