

# Hop Sing Laundry

**147-149 Sacramento Street**

- 1859 – Bernhard Levy and Henry Gillespie built this brick building after a fire destroyed the wooden building here.**
- 1870 – Hang Koy bought the building from Levy. Hang Koy and Lang Yet had a grocery store here.**
- 1874 – During a probate sale, B. R. Wells and Leong Yik Tong bought half of the building while Ah Sam bought the other half.**
- 1875 – Ah Sam sold his part of the building to Leung Yik Tong.**
- 1892 – Hong Fook Hong owned part of the building.**
- 1896 – Henry Bosse bought the building from Leung Yik Tong in a Sheriff's sale.**
- 1922 – The Hop Sing Laundry was at this location until 1944.**
- 1961 – Jehovah's Witness Kingdom Hall was here.**
- 1963 – George & Helen's Pet Shop was a tenant.**
- 1969 - The Exit Shop for books, pottery and candles.**
- 1980 – Gypsy Wind Antiques was a long-time occupant.**
