1852 – 49er Robert J. Fisher, the town carpenter and undertaker, had a building here.

1860s – Ed Holle had his bakery and saloon here and Simon Betton had another saloon right next door.

1877 – After a fire, Betton and Holle rebuilt their buildings on the same site.

1890s – Mrs. Betton owned the saloon here and Miss Pierce had her millinery shop here also.

1892 – Mrs. Holle sold the bakery to Adolph Beerman.

1900 – Betton's Saloon, Miss Pierce and the Beerman Bakery were still here.

1932 – Fire swept the block again.

1935 – Charlie Yue bought the three lots here and had Louis Wold put up this building. He called it the Gold Rush Plaza.
