

# The Benton Welty School

The Benton Welty School Room is located in the Auburn City Hall building.

This building was originally built to be a school. In 1915 it served as the Auburn Grammar School. At the present time the building serves a dual purpose as the home for the Auburn City Hall as well as a museum named 'The Benton Welty School Room.' Get a rare sense of old school days in a classroom packed with photos, scrapbooks, maps and old school books. Step back in time reading the Eclectic McGuffey Reader found on every desk. Try your hand at string games and penmanship. Due to its historic significance the building is listed in the National Register of Historic Places.
